Apprenticeship and School Information:

- Anyone can attend our Apprenticeship and Technical Training classes – you do not have to be a state registered apprentice or even working in the field you are interested in to attend classes.
- An Apprenticeship consists of two parts 1) is the accumulation of on-the-job hours of training and 2) is the related instruction (trade theory).
- Your sponsor (employer) provides the on-the-job training and must register you with the Delaware Department of Labor, the Apprenticeship and Training Department.
- New Castle County Vo-Tech Adult Education Division provides the related classroom instruction.
- The State of Delaware pays the tuition (\$280 or \$580) for Apprentices being sponsored by Delaware companies or Apprentices who are Delaware residents. All Apprentices are responsible for paying the \$120 Administrative Fee.

- Students who are residents of other states (usually Pennsylvania or Maryland) but are working for a Delaware company can be a Delaware Registered Apprentice and the State of Delaware will pay their tuition and issue their Journeyman Papers at the completion of their apprenticeship.
- Students who are residents of Delaware but work for a company in another state (usually Pennsylvania or Maryland) must be registered with that State's Apprenticeship Program but the State of Delaware will pay their tuition upon proof of Apprenticeship.
- Students who live and work in a state other than Delaware are welcome to attend classes but will need to pay the full tuition and administrative fee.
